



Rent bikes from the Museum of Regional History (10 -5 Tues thru Sats; 1–5 on Sundays. \$5/day includes bike locks and helmets) and new bike racks throughout. Funded by the Union Pacific (UP) Community Foundation. To celebrate the launch, guided bike tours of will be offered twice a day on Nov 18 and on December 2. Tours from 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. begin and end at the Museum of Regional History. Since bike share bikes may be limited for tours, participants are encouraged to bring and use their own bicycle.
